## Rate per Student

**\$18+HST (3 to 5hrs) ● \$15+HST (1 to 2hrs)**

(Maximum 90 students/visit)



Extra charges may apply for activities requiring professional staff. A **non-refundable deposit of \$200/date** is required for your booking to be secured. **Final numbers must be confirmed 1 week in advance.** Your final invoice will be prepared based on this number and **cannot be adjusted** if students are away or absent. A cheque with the total invoice amount will be due on the morning of your visit.

Groups will have access to the outdoor pool as of June 1<sup>st</sup>, weather permitting. The indoor pool will also be available. There is a minimum of 2 qualified lifeguards on duty at all times. A school staff member must remain on the pool deck while students are in the pool. Lifejackets are available for those who may require one, however students are encouraged to bring their own.

The OAC will provide an indoor or outdoor area to eat lunch, depending on the weather. A café is available to purchase sandwiches and snacks. Teachers and volunteers must ensure supervision in the café area.



Students should be divided into groups of 10-12 students. For each group, we are counting on the teacher to assign one or two parent volunteers to be responsible for supervision and discipline of their assigned group. All groups should be pre-arranged and ready to start the activities upon arrival. A counsellor will be assigned to lead your students through a fun session.

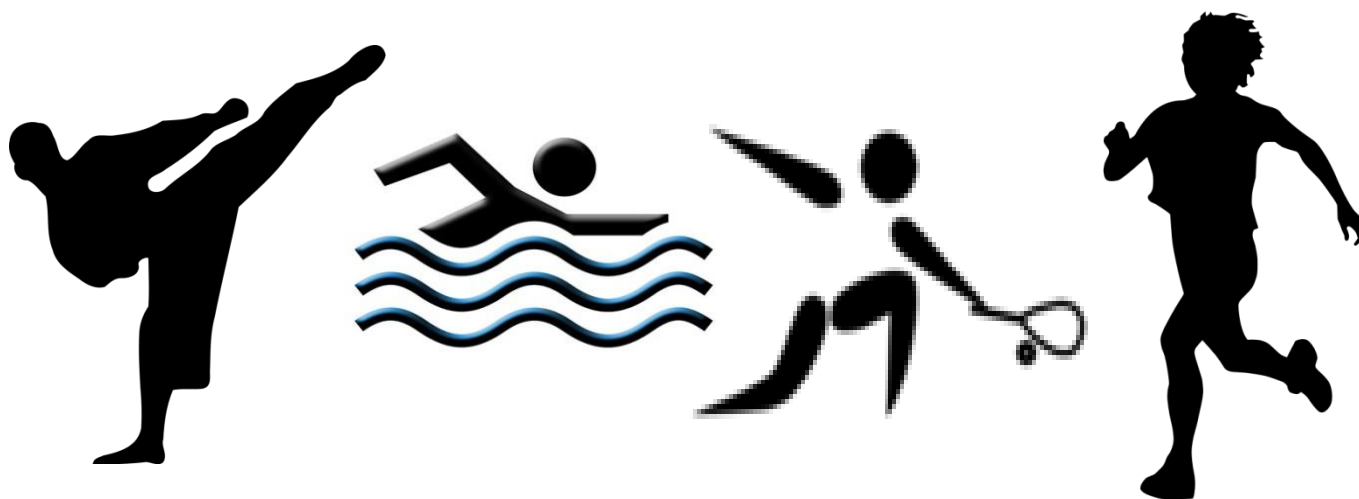
## The Role of Volunteers

Each group of students should have 1 to 2 volunteer parents or teachers assigned to them, preferably one male and one female adult. Volunteers are to be aware of the schedule and are responsible for the following:

- Volunteers will be responsible for the proper conduct as well as the safety of the students
- Volunteers will stay with their assigned groups at all times, even during lunch time
- Volunteers are welcome to participate in the activities as long as it is to create a fun atmosphere and does not distract from maintaining proper control of their group
- Volunteers must always accompany students to the locker rooms or washrooms
- Volunteers will ensure the proper circulation between the activity areas. Volunteers will accompany the students to ensure that they move quietly, in single file, from one assigned area to another.
- Smoking is not permitted in or around the facility premises.

## Student Code of Conduct and Club Rules

- This is a private club; as such we request that you respect our members.
- Your counsellor is here to run your activity, answer your questions and to make sure that you are safe at all times. Please respect what they say.
- **Activity privileges will be revoked from students who do not behave according to our rules.** Students may be barred from future visits.
- You will be required to clean up after your lunch.
- Do not bring gum as you will not be allowed to chew it during the day.
- Remember to bring your own bathing suit, towel, water bottle, hat, sun screen and appropriate workout clothing.
- Racquets and sports equipment will be provided on loan by the OAC. Students are welcome to bring their own racquets if they so desire.
- Only non-marking athletic shoes will be permitted.
- There will be separate bathrooms and change rooms for the students to use in the courtyard during the month of June.
